# **Applied Psychology**

# 1. Objectives:

The major aims to cultivate applicable students and specialists that master the basic theories and background knowledge of Psychological science, have the ability to solve mental problems with the Applied Psychology methods, present a high level of professionalism, and do relevant teaching, researches, psychological consultancy in schools, enterprises and institutions.

# 2. Duration limit: 4 years for undergraduate students

# 3. Degree conferred: Bachelor of Science

# 4. Requirements of credits:

Students should obtain 157 compulsory credits (extra-curriculum credits are exclusive), include 52 credits for General Compulsory Course, 9 credits for General Elective Courses, 43 credits for Major Elementary Courses, 33 credits for Major Compulsory Courses, 9 credits for Major Elective Courses, 11 credits for Comprehensive Application Courses, and 10 credits for Outbound extra-curriculum with the course of College Students Health Education.

#### 5. Requirements for Students from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan

According to the Education Department of Guangdong Province, the students from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan need not take courses from the sections of "Education of National Defense" and "Theory of Ideology and Politics". The students should strictly follow the teaching program, taking courses in the other sections.

#### 6. Requirements for Overseas Students

According to the Ministry of Education an Education Department of Guangdong Province, overseas students need not take courses from the section "Education of National Defense". Oversea students of economic disciplines should take courses of political theory, while the students of other disciplines could apply to be excused from it. The oversea students who receive education with record of formal schooling should take courses "Chinese" and "A Survey of China". Other courses should be taken strictly according to the teaching program.
