**Teaching Program for Business English Majors** 

(2014)

1. Training Goal: This teaching program aims to cultivate practice-oriented advanced professional personnel, with solid English foundation,

global vision, systematic knowledge of international business, and good literacy of Chinese and Western cultures. They are aimed to grasp basic

theories and principles on English linguistics & literature, business management, economics and international business laws, and to be aware of

the current rules in international business. They need to be provided with strong capabilities in cross-cultural business communication and

business information management, so as to make good use of English in the fields of foreign trade, management, finance, foreign affairs.

2. School Year: 4 years full-time

3. Degree Awarded: Bachelor of Arts

4. Credit Requirements: The students should obtain 155 credits (off-class credits not included), including the compulsory liberal courses for 38

credits, the optional liberal courses for 9 credits, the compulsory foundational courses for 58 credits, the optional foundational courses for 4

credits, the compulsory professional courses for 31 credits, the optional professional courses for 4 credits and the synthetically-applied courses

for 11 credits. In the meantime, students should obtain 10 credits from off-class programs, and take the course "Health Education for

Undergraduates".

5. Requirements for Students from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan

According to the Education Department of Guangdong Province, the students from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan need not take courses

from the sections of "Education of National Defense" and "Theory of Ideology and Politics". The students should strictly follow the teaching

program, taking courses in the other sections.

## 6. Requirements for Overseas Students

According to the Ministry of Education an Education Department of Guangdong Province, overseas students need not take courses from the section "Education of National Defense". Oversea students of economic disciplines should take courses of political theory, while the students of other disciplines could apply to be excused from it. The oversea students who receive education with record of formal schooling should take courses "Chinese" and "A Survey of China". Other courses should be taken strictly according to the teaching program.
