

Social work

1. Objectives:

The major of Social work aims to train a group of special applied talents who master both the theoretical and practical knowledge of social work, as well as the overall quality of humanistic and social sciences So as the graduates can do well in government sectors, enterprises, associations, communities, schools, hospitals and social service agencies, etc.

2. Duration limit: 4 years for undergraduate studies

3. Degree conferred: Bachelor of law

4. Requirements of credits:

Students should acquire 154 credits (not including extracurricular credits), in which the general compulsory occupied 52 credits, general elective courses 9 credits, basic courses 35 credits, compulsory course 33 credits, professional limit 12 credits, synthetic application course 13 credits, at the meantime, student should get 10 credits in the course of quality development, and to take the course health education of college students.

5. Requirements for Students from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan

According to the Education Department of Guangdong Province, the students from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan need not take courses from the sections of “Education of National Defense” and “Theory of Ideology and Politics”. The students should strictly follow the teaching program, taking courses in the other sections.

6. Requirements for Overseas Students

According to the Ministry of Education an Education Department of Guangdong Province, overseas students need not take courses from the section “Education of National Defense”. Oversea students of economic disciplines should take courses of political theory, while the students of other disciplines could apply to be excused from it. The oversea students who receive education with record of formal schooling should take courses “Chinese” and “A Survey of China”. Other courses should be taken strictly according to the teaching program.
