

Teaching Program for International Economics and Trade

(2015)

1. Training Goal: The specialty of International Economics and Trade aims at fostering advanced and applied talents who master the basic theories of Economics and the systematical knowledge of International Economics and Trade. They have good communication and coordination skills, strong innovative spirit, and great abilities to take up the tasks of international business management, business operations and quantitative analysis in all types of enterprises, public institutions and intermediary organizations.

2. School Year: 4 years full-time

3. Degree Awarded: Bachelor of Economics

4. Credit Requirements: Students should complete 155 credits (excluding extracurricular credits). They are 48 credits for Required Public Basic Courses, 9 credits for Electives Public Basic Courses, 48 credits for Basic Disciplinary Courses, 26 credits for Required Specialized Courses, 11 credits for Elective Specialized Courses, 13 credits for Comprehensive Practice Courses. At the same time, students must obtain 10 extracurricular quality development credits and study the course "College Student Health Education".

5.Requirements for Students from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan

According to the Education Department of Guangdong Province, the students from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan need not take courses from the sections of “Education of National Defense” and “Theory of Ideology and Politics”. The students should strictly follow the teaching program, taking courses in the other sections.

6. Requirements for Overseas Students

According to the Ministry of Education an Education Department of Guangdong Province, overseas students need not take courses from the

section “Education of National Defense”. Oversea students of economic disciplines should take courses of political theory, while the students of other disciplines could apply to be excused from it. The overseas students who receive education with record of formal schooling should take courses “Chinese” and “A Survey of China”. Other courses should be taken strictly according to the teaching program.
