

Teaching Program for Bachelor of Laws (Cooperate Governance)

(2014)

1. Training Goal: The Bachelor of Laws is designed to equip students with a solid foundation in legal theories and knowledge, to develop critical and **analytical skills**, to master the fundamental professional knowledge and techniques, to apply the legal theories and analytical skills in law and practice, and to cultivate a full-competence law students for law professionals and the academy.

2. School Year: 4 years full-time

3. Degree Awarded: **Bachelor of Laws**

4. Credit Requirements: To complete the curriculum(except the extracurricular courses), a candidate shall satisfy the examiners in at least 154 credits of courses, in the manner specified as follows:40 credits of Compulsory General Education Courses offered by any School of the University;70 credits of Professional Core Courses, 24 credits of disciplinary electives (legal practice)and 8 credits of advanced disciplinary electives; 12 credits of integrated practical exercises and pass the course of University Health Education

5. Requirements for Students from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan

According to the Education Department of Guangdong Province, the students from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan need not take courses from the sections of “Education of National Defense” and “Theory of Ideology and Politics”. The students should strictly follow the teaching program, taking courses of the other sections.

6. Requirements for Overseas Students

According to Ministry of Education an Education Department of Guangdong Province, oversea students need not take courses from the

section “Education of National Defense”. Oversea students of economic disciplines should take courses of political theory, while the students of other disciplines could apply to be excused from it. The overseas students who receive education with record of formal schooling should take courses “Chinese” and “A Survey of China”. Other courses should be taken strictly by the teaching program.
